A new "mobile lunch box" is stopping at Title 1 schools across the county, giving away goodie bags and prepackaged lunch boxes to teachers.


"I was really excited about coming out here and getting our little goodie bags," said Patrice West, a teacher at Ralph Bunche Elementary School.

Asm. Gipson Addresses Explosion in Wilmington

SACRAMENTO, Calif. (February 15, 2024) - In response to the compressed natural gas truck explosion that occurred in Wilmington today, Assemblymember Mike A. Gipson (D-Carson) released the following

"I applaud the twelve firefighters that responded to a truck fire early this morning in Wilmington, CA, and my heart goes out to the nine that were injured in the ensuing explosion. I commend the swift action of the first responders for aiding the injured firefighters and transporting them to nearby medical facilities, and I pray for their full recovery. Given this morning's tragedy, I am again reminded how courageous and selfless first responders are as they race toward danger to keep our communities safe Although residents are encouraged to stay inside, according to LAFD, no homes are in the immediate danger zone, and no evacuations have been ordered. My staff and I will continue monitoring the situation and keep the community apprised as additional updates are made available."





St. Patrick's Day Sandwiches

Yield: 8 sandwiches

8 ounces plain cream cheese spread, softened

1 cup finely shredded mozzarella cheese

salt

4 English muffins

24 slices cucumber

8 thin slices green pepper

fresh cilantro leaves

lemon juice

lemon slices, for garnish (optional)

In bowl, mix cream cheese spread, mozzarella cheese and salt well.

Split English muffins in half. Cut each muffin half into shamrock shape.

Spread cheese mixture over each muffin half.

Place three cucumbers on each "shamrock," one on each "leaf." Use green pepper slice as stem. Place cilantro leaf on top of each sandwich.

Sprinkle sandwiches with lemon juice and add lemon slices, for garnish, if desired.






